**The 3-phases of Salvation:**

- Justification – I \_\_\_\_\_ from

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**The 3-phases of Salvation:**

- Justification – I **AM SAVED** from the **PENALTY** of sin
- Sanctification – I am **BEING SAVED** from the **POWER** of sin.
- Glorification – I **WILL BE SAVED** from the **PRESENCE** of sin.

**Redemption** is the act by which God Himself **PAYS** as a ransom the price for sin which has **OUTRAGED** His holiness.

**Justification** is a **LEGAL TERM**. It is God's powerful, cosmic and universal action in **EFFECTING** a change in the situation between sinful humanity and God, by which God is able to **ACQUIT** believers, setting them in a right and faithful relation to himself.

**II.** What God does **FOR** us.

**MERCY** = God **DOES NOT** give us what we deserve.

**GRACE** = God gives us what we **DO NOT** deserve.

- God's **RICHES** at Christ's **EXPENSE**.
